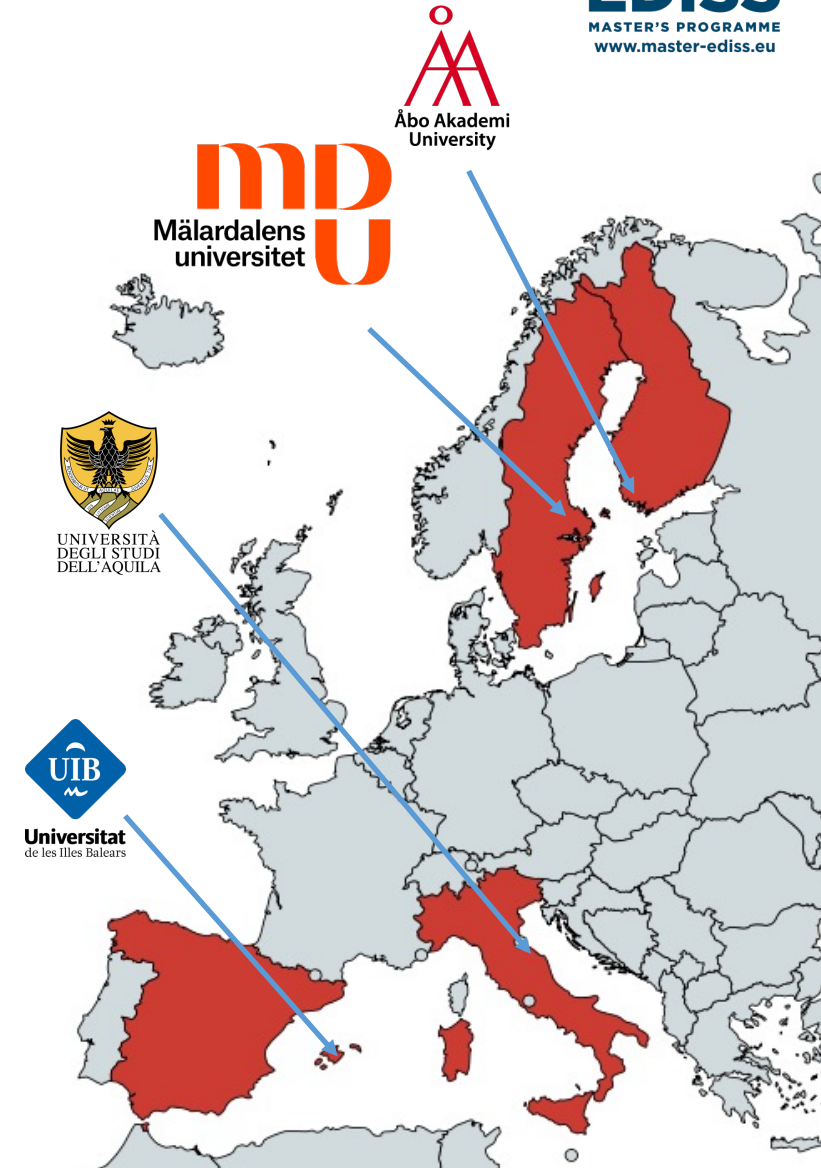

What you will learn in EDISS

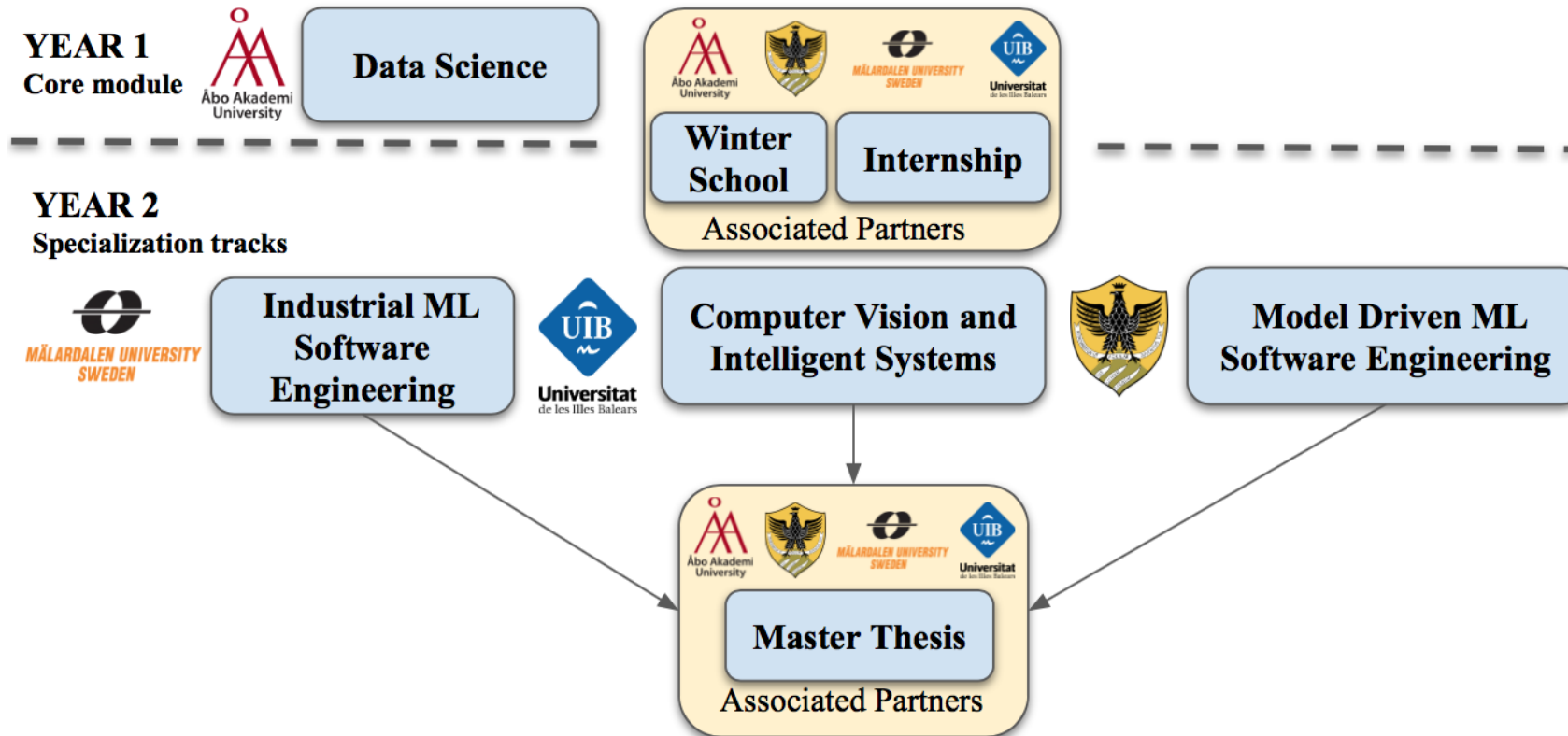
EDISS gives a holistic view of AI/ML, data science and software engineering

Admission requirements

Undergraduate degree (at least 180 ECTS)

- *Computer science*
- *Software engineering*
- *Equivalent subject*

Admission to the programme is competitive and only the best applicants are selected.

Good proficiency in English

- *TOEFL iBT, min. score 93*
- *IELTS Academic, min. overall score 6,5 and individual score 6*
- *Exception criteria*
 - *Australia, Canada, New Zealand, the UK, the USA, an EU/EEA country, Switzerland*

Participation costs

	Students from programme countries	Students from partner countries
Participation costs	4500 € / year	9000 € / year

Programme countries: EU member states and North Macedonia, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, Turkey, Serbia, Great Britain

Partner countries: all other countries

Participation cost includes

- Tuition fees (including courses, exams, academic supervision, university support services, orientation)
- Insurance (health and accident)
- Winter school participation (travel and accommodation costs)

Contribution to installation costs	<i>Country of residence</i>	-	1000€
Contribution to subsistence costs (max 24 months)	<i>Citizenship and Country of residence</i>	1000€/month	1000€/month

Erasmus Mundus scholarships



We expect to award 26 EMJMD scholarships for the 2024 intake:

- 3 programme country scholarship holders
- 15 partner country scholarship holders
- 3 additional scholarships for students from Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo or Montenegro
- 3 additional scholarships for students from Algeria, Egypt, Israel, Jordan, Lebanon, Libya, Morocco, Palestine, Syria or Tunisia
- 1 additional scholarship for students from Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan or Uzbekistan
- 1 additional scholarship for students from Bolivia, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras or Nicaragua

EDISS scholarships



EDISS scholarships offered by the EDISS consortium will be available for the first time in this upcoming application round

Scholarship	Students from programme countries	Students from partner countries
Contribution to participation costs	4 500€/year	9 000€/year
Contribution to subsistence costs – 1st year (12 months)	700€/month	700€/month
Contribution to subsistence costs – 2nd year (max 12 months)	300€/month *	300€/month *
Total	21 000€ over the 2-year programme	30 000€ over the 2-year programme

* for the 2nd year of the programme EDISS scholarship holders are eligible for the Erasmus+ mobility grant (490€ per month for the 2022-23 academic year)

We expect to award from 2 to 4 EDISS scholarships for the 2024 intake

Selected applicants on the waiting list for an Erasmus Mundus Scholarship will be proposed for the EDISS Scholarship.

Application period with scholarship 01.11.2023-02.01.2024

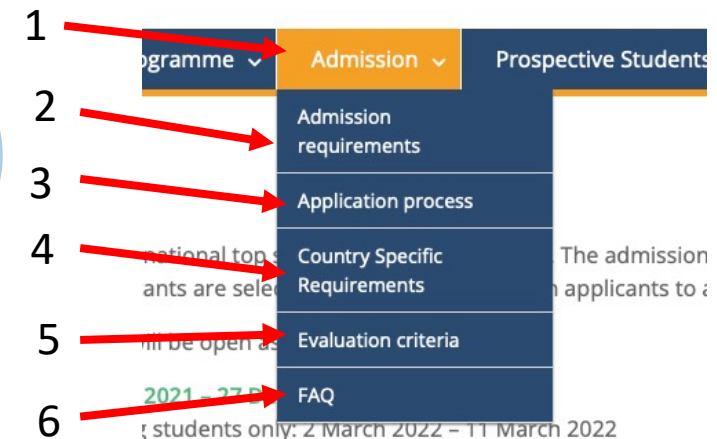
2. Prepare your application documents

3. Apply online at Studyinfo.fi within the deadline

5. Admission results are published by March 2024

6. Verification of original documents upon arrival in Finland

Admission Schedule (with scholarship)

- Application with scholarship open until **02.01.2024 3PM ETC+2 (Helsinki time)**
- Deadline to **update** enclosures to **submitted** application **9.01.2024 3PM ETC+2**
 - Allocate time to upload your enclosures! Uploading your video might take a lot of time!
- Admission results by March 2024
 - **Student awarded a scholarship will have 7 days to accept the offer**
- Deadline to send documents (degree and transcripts, translations) for conditionally admitted students: 26.07.2024
 - Apply only to students that didn't graduate by the application deadline
- Verification of original documents: upon arrival in Finland from August 2024
 - For admitted students only
- Start of the studies at Åbo Akademi University! August 2024
